

# WORLD OF WHISKEY



## **Ardbeg - 10 years Old** (Delux)

Sweet vanilla counterbalanced with lemon and lime followed by that surging Ardbeg smoke that we all know and love.

## **Talisker - 10 years old** (Delux)

Full bodied with huge plumes of smoke and volcanic, peppery peat. Intense.

## **Jura - Superstition** (Liquor)

Sweet and porridge-like. A cereal fest on the tongue, with hints of white pepper and black forest honey with hot buttered toast. Light and oily.

## **Lagavulin - 16 years old** (Delux)

Very thick and rich. A massive mouthful of malt and sherry with good fruity sweetness, but also a wonderful sweetness. Big, powerful peat and oak.

## **Highland park - 12 years old** (Delux)

Rather full with a pleasant depth. Lurking somewhere in the substratum a grilled orange lies. Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness.

## **Ardgeg Corryvreckan** (Superior)

Is a heady, intense and powerful expression. Swirling aromas and torrents of deep, peaty, peppery taste lurk beneath the surface of this beautifully balanced dream. It is the epitome of Ardbeg 'The Untamed Spirit of Islay'.

## **Laphroaig** (Liquor)

In the making of Laphroaig, malted barley is dried over a peat fire. The smoke from the peat gives Laphroaig it's particularly rich flavour.

## **Haig Club Clubman** (Liquor)

Single grain Scotch Whiskey matured in bourbon casks

## **Glenmorangie - The Original** (Delux)

The original Glenmorangie has flavours of honeyed sweetness, fused with notes of citrus, vanilla and almonds, making it delicate, alluring and very complex.

## **The Balvenie - 17 Year Old** (5.90)

During maturation, the Balvenie Double Wood is transferred from a traditional Whisky oak cask to a European oak Sherry cask, thereby acquiring character from each. This second cask ageing is at the heart of the Balvenie Double Wood and at 17 years of age is sweet with dried fruits, toasted almonds and spice, layered with coffee notes, oak and vanilla.

## **The Balvenie – 12 Year Old (4.50)**

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## **Bushmills Black Bush – Irish Whiskey (Liquor)**

Matured to perfection in Sherry casks

## **Anchentoshan American Oak – Single Malt Scotch Whiskey (Liquor)**

Anchentoshan stands alone. Born in 1823, it is Scotland's only remaining distillery to insist on triple distilling every drop. Auchentoshan American Oak is a smooth and complex single malt Scotch Whiskey, with notes of white peach and smooth vanilla cream.

## **Jack Daniels Single Barrel Select (Liquor)**

Originally released for the Travel Retail market, this is Jack Daniel's Single Barrel 100 Proof, which is bottled at a slightly higher strength than the standard Jack Daniel's Single Barrel.

## **The Glenlivet Single Malt Scotch Whiskey (Delux)**

Established 1824. Single malt from a timeless valley of icy waters from the River Livet. Rich and elegant flavour.

## **Makers Mark (Liquor)**

Kentucky straight bourbon whiskey, one of the rising stars in the premium bourbon market.

## **Glenfiddich (Liquor)**

Carefully matured in the finest American oak and European oak sherry casks, mellowed to create its sweet and subtle oak flavours. Creamy with a long smooth and mellow finish.

## **Jim Beam Devil's Cut (Liquor)**

Immensely woody, fresh cut oak and a whole heap of vanilla and wood spice. A punchy oak fest of a bourbon.

## **Gentleman Jack (Liquor)**

A premium version of Jack Daniel's Tennessee whiskey, Gentleman Jack exhibits impressive complexity and flavour. It enjoys a 'double mellowing' as it's filtered through charcoal before being filled into the barrel.
